POLICY

USE OF TEAM MANAGERS AT SWIMMINGSA EVENTS

Effective 27th June 2011



The purpose of this document is to provide adequate recognition to team managers:

SwimmingSA's Definition of team manager is –

- A person who is a member of an affiliated Club; and
- Has been duly appointed as the point of contact for the Club at a SwimmingSA event.

THE POLICY

As of the 1st July 2011, each Club who competes at a SwimmingSA event needs to nominate a Club Team Manager in the form prescribed by SwimmingSA for each event. (*Note: this maybe online or paper based*)

Swimming SA will provide to each Club

- One free pool entry to the prescribed Club Team Manager for each session for all Clubs competing at a SwimmingSA hosted swim meets.
- 2. One free program to each Club Team Manager competing at each event. (Note: this is one program per event not session, Clubs are responsible for handing on programs if a Team Manager changes)
- 3. Additional team manager pool deck accreditations will be made available to Clubs at a ratio of 1 pass per 10 athletes for JX meets and can be collected at the team manager briefing. (Note: this is only a pool deck pass not free entry)

Adoption of Strategies

SwimmingSA will supply a ticket or pass, which can be collected at the event entry prior to the start of the Swim Meet. (Once electronic ticketing is applied to the venue, tickets may be emailed to the Club Secretary for distribution).

ASCTA Coaches also receive 1 free entry per session and 1 free program per event. ASCTA Coaches are required to present their ASCTA membership card to obtain this benefit.
